The fact that he had previously spent so much time in St. Louis, made the transition smoother than it might have been otherwise. Asa adjusted quite well and attended elementary through high school in St. Louis and graduated from Kirkwood High School in 2009.

After graduating from high school, Asa attended Forest Park Community College where he earned an Associate's Degree in Accounting in 2012. College is also where his love of performing flourished. He started taking improv classes and began acting in short films. He worked hard to save money to move to Atlanta, Georgia in 2015, where he sought to further his acting career.


