Alice Louise LaBreacht Click passed away surrounded by her family on Wednesday, September 20, 2017 in St. Louis, Missouri. Born November 4, 1920 in Koblenz, Germany, Alice was 96 years old.

Alice grew up in St. Louis, Missouri. She was an avid learner and strongly believed in the value of good education. She graduated from Soldan High School at age 16. She attended Harris Teachers College until World War II started and then she went to work at Emerson Electric where she met her husband, James Weldon Click. Alice and Jim were married on September 18, 1941 and were blessed with three children. Alice received her college education degree in 1961 from Washington University. She and her family moved to Eureka in 1957 where she taught fourth grade for many years. Alice loved to be outside taking walks and photographing nature. She spent much of her childhood exploring Forest Park and later taking hikes on their property in Eureka. Alice and Jim traveled frequently and also took their grandchildren on several exciting and educational adventures. She was a voracious reader and skilled game player frequently answering the winning question in Trivial Pursuit and beating her grandchildren at Rummy Cube.
