Drew was also a gifted musician playing finger-style acoustic guitar and he dabbled with electric guitar, piano, banjo and violin as well. He loved to play card games and old-school video games as well as drawing caricatures and funny figures. Additionally, Drew was skilled in the design and implementation of printed circuit boards for electronic components and made several impressive devices including several effects pedals for use with his electric guitar. He used these skills to excel in the Mars Rover program at MS&T where he participated on the telemetry team. He was a handsome, bright, witty and creative young man. If only he had been able to see that in himself. After a lengthy battle, Drew succumbed to the illness of depression and chose to end his life.
