Beverly May Boyer (née Stahl), age 79, of De Soto, Missouri, passed away peacefully on July 29, 2025, in De Soto. She was born on December 11, 1945, in St. Louis, Missouri, the daughter of the late Earl Stahl and the late Dorothy Stahl (née Gray). Beverly worked several jobs throughout her life, but her passion was always in cosmetology. She loved styling hair and spent many years working in beauty shops, where she made countless friends and left a lasting impression on her clients. One of her proudest memories was styling the hair of several Miss America contestants during her time at the J.C. Penney Beauty Salon, while the pageant was held in St. Louis — a moment she often referred to as her “claim to fame.” On October 21, 1967, Beverly married the love of her life, Wayne Boyer, at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Crystal City. They shared 57 years of love, laughter, and unwavering commitment. In 1971, they welcomed their only child, a son, Gary. Though Gary describes himself as a sickly, hyperactive, rebellious handful of a child, Beverly’s love, guidance, and patience (along with a few spankings and the classic “wait till your father gets home”) helped shape him into the man he is today. Beverly was a devoted and loving grandmother and great-grandmother. Her kindness and generosity knew no bounds, and she was always ready with a hug, a listening ear, or a home-cooked meal. Her family was her pride and joy, and she poured her heart into every role she held — wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, and friend.
