



## Bill (William) James McCabe

December 28, 1955 - March 15, 2021

On Monday, March 15, 2021, Bill (William) James McCabe, loving husband and father, passed away at age 65.

Bill was born on December 28, 1955, in Galesburg, IL, to Jim and Evelyn (Bauer) McCabe, who both preceded him in death. He married his wife, Angela, on September 8, 1979, and together they raised three daughters. Bill was a volunteer firefighter for the Cedar Hill Fire Department for several years. He also worked as a salesman selling rubber to mines and quarries for 43 years.
