



## Clara L. Hagerman

April 5, 1931 - June 29, 2022

Clara L. Hagerman (née Nelson) passed away at her home in Chesterfield, MO, on Wednesday, June 29, 2022, at the age of 91.

She was born on April 5, 1931, to Robert Raymond and Grace Stamm Nelson in Sedan, KS. After her father passed away when she was four years old, Clara lived with her family in Dayton, OH, for a few years before they moved to Lawrence, KS. In Lawrence, Clara finished grade school and graduated from Lawrence High School in 1949.
