Clarence Allen Miller, 73, went with the angels on Tuesday, November 12, 2024.

Clarence was the beloved husband of Peggy Lorraine Miller (nee Glass) for 53 wonderful years and the loving father of Steven Allen Miller. He was preceded in death by his parents, John and Betty Miller (nee Koch), and his brother, Bertman Earl Miller, who gave his life serving in Vietnam.

Clarence was a devoted husband, father, uncle, cousin, and friend.

An avid fisherman, Clarence found joy in casting a line from the riverbank or lakeside, with Peggy behind him in a lawn chair, reading a good book. From the first days of spring until the chill of winter, the two were inseparable, spending weekends hunting for treasures at yard sales and garage sales.

Their love story began in the 1970s at Rite Point Pen Co. in Crestwood, MO, where Peggy worked and first noticed Clarence. She was smitten immediately, though briefly disheartened by the mistaken belief that he was married. When she learned he wasn't—and that he was equally interested in her—their relationship blossomed quickly. Clarence proposed after just a few months, and they married on June 12, 1971. This year marked their 53rd wedding anniversary.

When winter set in, Clarence turned his attention to indoor hobbies, challenging himself with intricate jigsaw puzzles—including 3D ones like the White House and Notre Dame—and painting collectibles or creating

tapestries. He was also a natural handyman, never content to sit still.

One of Peggy's favorite stories about Clarence recalls his days snow plowing. After hours of clearing roads and working through his second thermos of coffee, nature called. Clarence searched for a secluded spot to take a break but noticed a line of cars following safely in his plow tracks. Unable to stop, he dutifully led the caravan back to safety before finishing his route—earning himself a long, memorable night.

Clarence and Peggy loved road trips, exploring the beauty of America. For their 25th wedding anniversary, they traveled to Las Vegas, where they renewed their vows in a ceremony that marked their deep bond. Clarence wore his best dark blue suit, and Peggy donned a blue velvet dress, complete with a boutonniere and bouquet, before enjoying a second honeymoon.

Clarence's life was one of devotion, humor, and love for his family and friends.
