Wilson, David Woody of Crestwood, Missouri, was born January 30, 1950 in San Diego, California and entered into rest Tuesday, August 27, 2024 in St. Louis, Missouri at the age of 74 years.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Luther “Woody” and Vivian (nee Polk) Wilson; his son, Sean Wilson; and his brother, Robert “Dennis” Wilson.

He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Vari Wilson; two (2) daughters, Verdell Wilson and April Wilson; his four (4) grandchildren, Michael Wilson, Devyn Wilson, Sean-Pierre Akers-Kennedy, and Aidan Kalinsky; along with numerous other extended family and friends.

David proudly served in the United States Army as an Electronic Warfare Specialist and Signal Intelligence Morse Interceptor during the Vietnam War. His 20-year military career was distinguished by numerous honors, including the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam War Medal, Meritorious Unit Citation, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Army of Occupation Medal (Japan), and many more.

After retiring from the Army, David channeled his expertise into founding a

successful personal security and protection business, where he continued to make a positive impact. He also took great pride in leading a local neighborhood watch program, demonstrating his commitment to keeping his community safe.

An avid gamer, David embraced technology and had a passion for massively multiplayer strategy games, dedicating hours and hours to playing with and mentoring fellow gamers from all over the world. Outside of games, he enjoyed Celtic folk music, painting, and crafting. A history buff and proud Missourian, he was passionate about reading and sharing knowledge, particularly about the rich history and people of Missouri. His favorite quote was, "I am from Missouri. You have got to show me."

David will always be remembered for a staunch commitment to his principles and strong sense of purpose. May he rest in peace.
