DOYLE LANCE of Iron Mountain Lake, Missouri was born July 10, 1936 in Dunklin County, Missouri to Chester and Jetta Pearl (nee Parmer) Lance and died Thursday, November 19, 2020 at Camelot Nursing and Rehab Center in Farmington, Missouri at the age of 84 years 4 months and 9 days.
