



## Edgar Winford Garrett

August 27, 1932 - September 29, 2020

GARRETT, Edgar Winford, of St. Charles, Missouri, formerly of House Springs, Missouri, was born August 27, 1932, in Conway, Arkansas, to Earl James Garrett and Mary D. (nee Boardman) Garrett-Wilson and entered into rest Tuesday, September 29, 2020 in St. Charles, Missouri at the age of 88 years, 1 month and 2 days.

He is preceded in death by his parents and five (5) siblings, Harold Garrett, Dale Garrett, Allan Garrett, Roger Garrett, Morris Garrett.

selected in the inaugural year of the Athletic Division of the Northwest Hall of Fame. He enjoyed playing golf and watching the Detroit Tigers and St. Louis Cardinals. Our husband, father, and grandfather was highly respected and dearly loved.
