EDWIN H. SCHULZE of House Springs, Missouri was born March 26, 1966 in St. Louis, Missouri to Charles and Sharon (nee Lony) Schulze and died Saturday, January 12, 2013 at his home in House Springs, Missouri at the age of 46 years 9 months and 16 days.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Charles and Sharon Schulze.

He is survived by his sister, Kay (husband, Chris) Elmore of House Springs, Missouri and many other relatives and friends.

Ed devoted his life to his faith and his family. Both literally and figuratively he “built churches” where the word of God would be revealed. He was a Sunday School Teacher and adored his Godson, Colin. As a Senior at Northwest High School in 1984, Ed captured the Individual State Wrestling Title in the 185 Pound Weight Class on his way to leading the Lions to their first ever Team Wrestling Championship. What Ed would probably like us to remember most, though, is the extraordinary job he did raising his sister, Kay.
