Elizabeth "Libby" Greene Willis was born March 18th, 1944, to George D. and Mary E. Greene and passed away July 2, 2024, at her home at the age of 80. She attended Maryland Elementary School and graduated from Clayton High School in 1962. She graduated from Stephen's College in Columbia and graduated from the University of Arizona at Tucson, where she joined Phi MU Sorority. She married Robert Willis in 1979.

Libby is preceded in death by her parents, son Robert Sheldon Willis and husband Robert Donald Willis.
