November 7, 1920 - October 10, 2014

Elmer J. Freise, 93, died on Friday, October 10th, 2014.

He was born to John "Pop" and Erna (nee Kronenberger) Freise on November 7, 1920, in St. Louis, MO.

He was preceded in death by the love of his life, Betty Green, his brother, Roy Freise, and his parents. Survivors include his son, Lee K. Freise of Crestwood, MO; his granddaughter Tracy L. Freise of St. Louis, MO; and cherished loved ones Glenn, LuAnn and Jordan Mazuranic of High Ridge, MO.

Mr. Freise spent his life in St. Louis and Hannibal, Missouri. He worked for Heil Packing Company for 20 years and drove for Butler Electric Company for another 10 years. He also worked part time as a driver for Rustman Bus Company. He was a World War II veteran and served as an Army PFC anti-aircraft artillery gunman. He arrived on the beaches of Normandy on the 2nd

day of D-Day on June 7, 1944.
