Gary Francis Rosener, 68, of Green Park, Missouri, died Wednesday, Dec. 18, 2019, at his residence. He was born Sept. 17, 1951, in St. Louis to the late Deloris Keller and Francis Rosener.

On May 20, 1972 in High Ridge, Missouri, he was married to Linda (Hartupée) Rosener, who survives. He was preceded in death by his parents, and "the old man" Harold Keller, his step-father.
