



Geraldine A. Brischetto

November 24, 1918 - July 15, 2014

Geraldine (Gerry) Lilie Brischetto died peacefully at home on July 15, 2014, surrounded by family in Webster Groves. She was born in St. Louis on Nov. 24, 1918, to Marie (Flori) and Charles Lilie. Gerry was predeceased by her husband, Air Force Colonel Roy R. Brischetto, who died in a jet crash in 1955 in Bitburg, Germany. Her sisters, Rosemary Gaebler and Genevieve Guerrant, also predeceased her. She is survived by her daughters, Charlene Lilie, Judy and husband David Murnan, Elizabeth and husband Frank Kochin, and sons Robert Brischetto and wife Barbara and Richard Brischetto, six grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.

After her husband's death, Gerry returned to St. Louis to raise her five children, ages 2-12. She completed her degree in elementary education from Webster College in 1960 and a master's degree while teaching second grade at Long Elementary School before her retirement in 1978. She opened her home to foreign exchange students from Webster University. She enjoyed playing bridge with life-long school friends and teacher retirees. Her life story is told in a book of memoirs, self published in 2007.
