Jewell Ray Steele was born on October 5, 1922, in Powerdly, Kentucky, a son of Charles and Vola (Mercer) Steele and departed this life on Monday, May 25, 2015, at Christian Healthcare South in Lebanon, Missouri, where he had been in failing health. Mr. Steele had attained the age of 92 years, 7 months, and 20 days.
