Joyce M. Jarvis, 80, died Thursday, April 24, 2025, at her Festus home with her family by her side.

Joyce was born October 13, 1944, in Crossville, Missouri, to Earl and Majorie Barton. Career driven and successful, she married Kenith W. Jarvis Sr. on June 9, 1984, after fate had crossed their paths as co-workers at Brown Shoe Company.
