Karen Rose Tucker (nee: Webers) peacefully answered God's call to come home on October 11, 2025. Karen was born on June 5, 1942, in St. Louis, Missouri, the first child of Lillian and Herman Webers.

She spent most of her life in St. Louis, Missouri. Graduating from Cleveland High School in 1960, where she met her future husband and life partner Virgil Tucker. Karen and Virgil married in January 1962 and welcomed their son Michael in 1964. They made their home in South St. Louis for many years and were active members of Unity Church.

Karen was a born organizer using these talents in her career as an Executive Assistant at Freund Baking Company, Office Manager at Commerce Clearing House, and Wolters Kluwer until her retirement.

After retiring, Karen served as an on-call Branch Office Assistant for Edward Jones and organized many activities for the Foggy River Boys Fan Club and the Cleveland High School Class of 1960.
