believe there is any household or automotive mechanical problem that he could not fix. Many times I presented Kevin with a problem and would give him some space to think it through and he would come up with the solution.

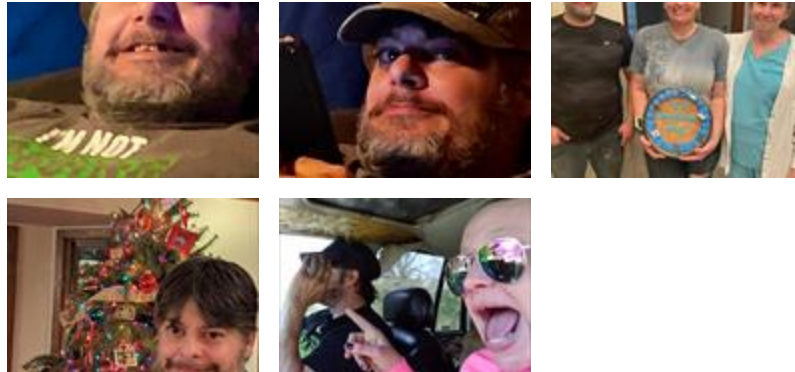
