January 26, 1938 - April 4, 2021

Lamont, Lanny of Lake St. Louis, Missouri, entered into rest on Sunday, April 4, 2021 at the age of 83.

He was preceded in death by parents James and Juanita Lamont and sister Vicki. He is survived by Kay, his loving spouse of 54 years, daughters Lisa (John) Uhlenbrock, Laura (Marcel) Vandenberg, and Michelle (Brian) Buckley.

He was so proud of his life's work at Davlan, which he helped grow from its humble beginnings in a fruit cellar to a state-of-the-art machining and fabrication company.

He held board positions at YMCA Lake of the Ozarks, Laumeier Sculpture Park, Affton Education Foundation, Ranken Technical College, and served on the Bradley University Advisory Board, and as a Trustee of Webster Hills

United Methodist Church.

Lanny never met a stranger. He knew how to connect with people, made them feel important and always made them laugh. He loved to travel with his wife Kay and family, painted as a hobby, and spent many happy days on the golf course.
