October 23, 1928 - February 12, 2018

Lester Edward Meyer, of Cedar Hill, Missouri, passed away on February 12, 2018 at SSM St. Clare Hospital in Fenton, Missouri. Mr. Meyer was born on October 23, 1928, and was 89 years, 3 months, and 20 days old. He was the son of the late William G. and Ella (Cronk) Meyer.

Mr. Meyer was retired from Cupples, Inc. in Maplewood, Missouri, where he worked for 30 years as an expeditor. He and his family raised a large garden and strawberry patch on their property and sold their bounty to friends and neighbors in the community. 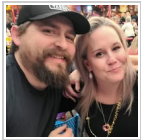
