“ Believe this William Odor could be my close Edmond Oklahoma High School friend except for the information posted that he was born in Pennsylvania.

We were six close friends in high school in 1942 and we called ourselves the STB"s. At that time Bill went with Janice Snyder and upon graduation he joined the Army. Harry Manning and I joined the Marines, Cranston Flesher joined the Navy, and Johnnie Wantland went to the Unv. of Okla. I"m not sure what Bill Harr did upon graduation although I later learned that the was killed in an airplane crash.

The Bill Odor I knew received a field commission as a Lt.in Europe. I believe the Bill"s father played the trombone and later designed and patented what became known as the Vornado Fan. I recall that the family later moved south of Edmond and Bill told me that the proceeds Mr. Odor received from his patent had created some hard feeling among his siblings. The Bill Odor I knew had a younger brother and I believe his name was Paul. His older sister Dorothy married Bill Howell.
