Motorcycling with friends was a great passion of theirs, and being members of GWRRA (Gold Wing Road Riders Association) gave them many new opportunities for friendship and adventure. Their shared love of traveling transferred from the Goldwings to a motorhome which opened new roads for fresh expeditions.

Marcia was a vivacious, effervescent, inquisitive woman who enjoyed learning and sharing her knowledge. She was also a children's advocate for higher quality teaching, for better health and for better lives. She cherished her family, especially her husband, Virgil, with whom she journeyed through 55 years of marriage. Gardening, carpentry, home decorating, traveling, being a tailor-seamstress, and genealogy were just a few of the hobbies Marcia relished. For all of these things brought her much joy - laughing, loving, and the good times most importantly.
