



## Margie Miller

January 20, 1941 - September 23, 2013

Margie Lou Miller, daughter of Gaius Robert and Edna L. nee Krohne Allan, was born January 20, 1941 in St. Louis, MO. She received her elementary education in the public schools and graduated in January 1960 from O'Fallon Technical School with a concentration in stenography. In 1957 she was baptized at Maplewood Bible Chapel and on June 15, 2000 she became a communicant at Peace Lutheran church where her membership since has remained.

On November 19, 1960 she united with Donald Merle Miller with whom she experienced nearly 53 years in the nuptial estate.

Yet, despite diminishing health in recent years, she was able to remain at home under the care of her husband and family until admission of St. Anthony's Medical Center on September 14. After a brief stay, she was placed under hospice care and returned home on September 18 where she remained until her passing early Monday, September 23, 2013. She attained the age of 72 years, 8 months and 3 days.
