She worked as a nurse in New York City for two years. On March 2, 1943, she married Robert B. Johnson in Manhattan, Kansas. After their marriage, they lived in several states throughout the country before moving to Yankton in September of 1956. She was an active member of United Church of Christ Congregational and was very involved in her quilters group and the layette committee, she organized rummage sales and helped with the soup kitchens. She was an avid genealogist and a long term member of Daniel Newcomb Chapter of the Daughter's of the American Revolution.

Survivors include three children and their spouses, David and Linda Johnson of Pueblo, Colorado, Pete and Janet Johnson of Yankton, South Dakota and Edwin and Michelle Johnson of Wakonda, South Dakota, one daughter, Sarah and Rodger Johnson of Falls City, Nebraska,
She is preceded in death by her parents, her husband Robert on September 13, 1994, three brothers and one sister.
