September 22, 2015. Born in Mesa, Arizona, Miss Chase was recruited from Michigan to help form the Special School District in St. Louis, established in 1957. Miss Chase hired and trained the first teachers as well as providing for all of the facilities. She developed the program for the visually impaired for St. Louis County. She initiated and directed the in-hospital program at Shriners Hospital. She was the first president of the local chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma, an international organization which encourages women educators. Miss Chase helped countless children and families deal with physical challenges. Her joy in life was when former students and teachers called her to share their successes. She dedicated her life to the departments and students she served. Olive was a loving aunt and faithful friend.
