Pamela (Pam) Schmidt, homemaker, wife, and mother died on July 26th, 2018 at the age of 70.

Pam was born April 1, 1948 to J.R. (Ralph) and Bess (Drury Weixelman) Stierwalt in Manhattan, Kansas. She attended Kansas State University and graduated with a degree in Biology. On February 14, 1970, she married Jerry Schmidt in Manhattan, Kansas. neighborhood events, and hosting friends and family.

She is survived by Jerry, her husband of 48 years, three sons, Erik (Sarah) of Chicago, Tom (Mickie) of Kirkwood, Jim (Sarah) of St. Louis, and daughter, Anne Shearer (Jeff) of Creve Coeur; seven granddaughters, Leah, Julie, Allison, Emmy, Cora, Charlotte, and Gwendolyn, and five grandsons, Connor, Samuel, Liam, Dylan, and Wyatt, in addition to brother Dean Weixelman of Camdenton, MO, nephews, nieces, and many dear friends.
