Bowen, Quinten Bernell, of Washington Missouri, formerly of House Springs, Missouri, was born January 12, 1924, in Van Buren, Missouri, to Everett E. and Leona L. After retiring from the electric company, he worked at the church for 22 years as a Sunday school teacher and an Outreach director. He will be fondly remembered and dearly missed by all who knew and loved him.
