Rich Warren, age 87, born in Indianapolis, Indiana went to be with our Lord and Savior on Monday, December 17, 2018 in the Meramec Bluffs Senior Living community in Ballwin, Missouri. In 1967 he started the firm of Brusco-Rich, Inc. which was the predecessor of Thermal Mechanics, Inc., a distributor of heating, air conditioning, industrial heat transfer, and temperature control equipment. He was a great leader that built his company to thrive well beyond his retirement.

Warren was a journeyman golfer at Forest Hills Country Club and always enjoyed the game. He was a lifetime supporter of the Purdue Boilermakers as a member of the Presidents Council and John Purdue Club. He was an avid Boilermaker fan to the end.
