Robert Lee Roskowske, of High Ridge, Missouri, was born June 24, 1936 in Valley Park, Missouri to Otto and Daisy (nee Huff) Roskowske and went to be with his Lord on Thursday, August 5, 2021 at his home in High Ridge, Missouri at the age of 85 years, 1 month and 14 days.

He is preceded in death by his parents and three siblings: Arthur, Luella and Otto, Jr.
