Bob was Elected Jefferson County Prosecuting Attorney in 1994 and proudly served from 1995 – 2006. During his time as Prosecutor, he founded the

Children's Advocacy Center and served as Executive Board President from 2000 – 2006. He also helped to create the Jefferson County drug court and domestic violence program. He was a member of the National District Attorneys Association and the Missouri Association of Prosecuting Attorneys where he proudly served as President in 2005. After his years of service in the Prosecutor's office, in 2007 he was elected as Circuit Judge serving the county in Circuit 23, Division 1 until retirement in 2016. During his time in office as a Prosecutor and a judge, he was the recipient of numerous awards. He was also a member of the House Springs Lions Club and served as Club President 1999-2000.

Funeral services will be private followed by a public Visitation on Monday, April 27 from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. at CHAPEL HILL MORTUARY, 6300 Highway 30, Cedar Hill, Missouri. Visitation will be organized in small gatherings with attendees receiving numbers when they arrive on-site, remaining in their cars and entering when they are invited by number. Attendees will also be able to participate in a Memorial Procession while remaining in their cars. 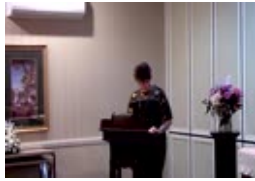
