Weil, Thomas Andrew, passed away on Friday, July 10, 2015, after a long battle with multiple myeloma, with his wife, son and sister by his side.

Beloved husband of Kay Weil for 38 years; dear father of Timothy Weil (Keddie) and the late Emily Weil; loving grandfather of Henry Weil; dear brother of Elizabeth (Betsy) Spomer and the late Margaret Schuermann; and dear brother-in-law, uncle, cousin and friend to many.

Tom was born in St. Louis on December 26, 1944 to Justin and Dorothy Weil. He grew up in University City and graduated from University City High School in 1963. Tom obtained his degree from Westminster College, Class of 1967, where he was a dedicated member of the Beta Theta Pi fraternity. After graduating from college he proudly served as a Second Lieutenant, tank unit commander, in the 4th Armored Division of the U.S. Army, earning a National Defense Service Medal. He later met his wife, Kay, in Louisville, KY and the couple moved back to St. Louis to raise their two children. Tom was an avid Cardinals fan, loved the outdoors and his dog, River, and will be remembered for his unshakable optimism in the face of enormous challenges.
