I laughed and said "but where will he sleep?!" To which Domino pointed out he in fact had bunk beds Tom could share with him.

I referred to Tom by name and Domino diligently corrected me telling me "no! That's the neighbor"! He literally thought that was his name. Haha!

Anytime I think of Tom, I recall those years my son idolized him and the way it made both of them smile.
