Victoria Stearns Lloyd passed away September 24th on the eve of her 98th birthday. Victoria was born in 1916, in Concord, Massachusetts, daughter of Margaret Morrill Stearns and Raymond Hayden Stearns.

She was a talented artist who won many awards, and attended Boston University College of Practical Arts and Letters on two scholarships. Married to the late Henry Lloyd in 1940, she moved to California during the war years and remained there until 1958 painting both landscape and portraits and held several one-man shows. After a move to New Jersey, she worked on more impressionist and abstract painting. Vicky moved to St. Louis in 1962, where she was an active painter and enjoyed amateur ballroom dancing. She enjoyed travel and made several trips to the Far East.

She is survived by a son Henry Lloyd (Julie), daughter Margaret Peggy) Miles, and son David Stearns Lloyd (Vickie), seven grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.
