



William "Bill" Henderson

December 9, 1925 - February 25, 2007

Bill was a graduate of the University of Missouri Columbia, and a member of Phi Kappa Psi fraternity. A WWII Navy veteran, he served in both Atlantic and Pacific Theaters, He was the Editor of The Record, Rocket, Booster, and the De Soto Republic and Press, Jefferson County's first purchasing agent, and Hillsboro City's first Municipal Judge. Bill was a past member of Hillsboro City Council, Past board member and President of the Hillsboro R-3 School District Board of Education, known as the "Voice of the Hawks", Hillsboro Food Pantry Board member/Volunteer, former Secretary of the Hillsboro Fire Protection District Board of Directors, lifetime member of the B.P.O.E Elks, #689 De Soto and editor of Elks State publication. Charter member of Hillsboro Rotary club, member of the Hillsboro Civic Club, organized and coached Little League in Hillsboro and worked at the district level, liaison to the National Election News Service, Jefferson Memorial Hospital Volunteer, Elder of the Hillsboro Presbyterian Church Greater Hillsboro Chamber of Commerce "Citizen of the Year" and recipient of the Jeffersonian Award.
